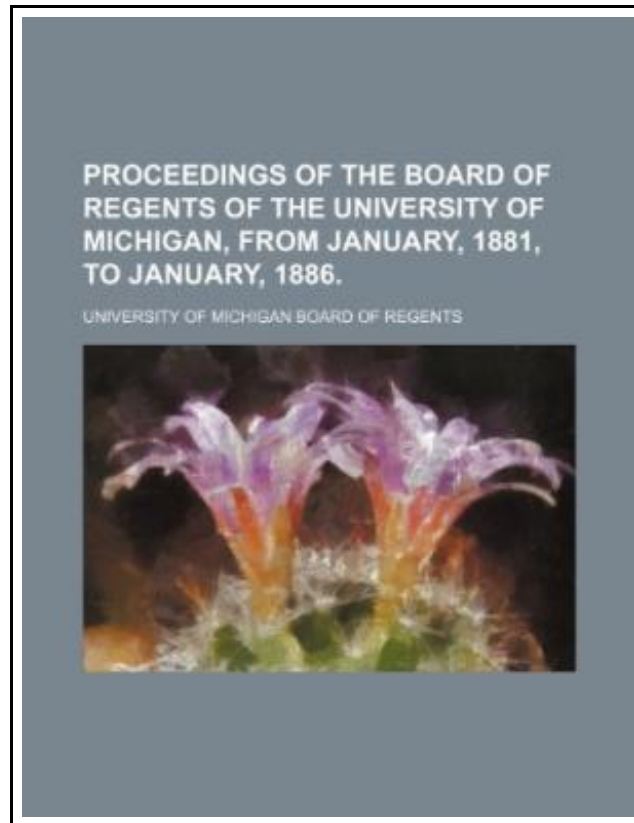

Present--The President, Regents Walker, Duffield, Yan Riper, Grosvenor, Shearer, Blair and Joy. The meeting was called to order and opened with devotional exercises by the President. The minutes of the two preceding meetings were approved as printed, on motion of Regent Grosvenor. The President stated that his annual report had been prepared and was held subject to the pleasure of the Board. Regent Grosvenor moved that the report be read by the President. The motion prevailed. PRESIDENTS REPORT. To the Honorable Board of Regents: In offering to you my annual report for the academic year ending September 30th, 1882, I desire first of all to thank you most sincerely for the kindness with which you granted me leave of absence in 1880 to undertake important diplomatic duties entrusted to me by the President of the United States. I wish also to make most hearty and grateful recognition of the eminent services of Dr. Frieze, who at your request assumed, the burdens of my office and brought to his work an energy and skill, which largely conduced to the marked prosperity of the University during the last two years. I cannot but congratulate you on the evidences which I find of the progress that was made during my absence. The Eye and Ear Infirmary was erected, the sewer...
