




Secrets of the Seasons: Orbiting the Sun in Our Backyard (Hardback)

Two very helpful and very funny chickens give more science details and further explanation through charts, diagrams, and sidebars. Packed with sensory details, humor, and solid science, this book makes a complicated concept completely clear for young readers and also for the many parents who struggle to answer their kids questions!
